RE: Guidelines for Political Activity at City Hall

City Hall will serve as a voting precinct from March 24, 2014 to April 8, 2014. As such, please be mindful of the following guidelines:

- There shall be no campaigning or campaign materials displayed or distributed within one hundred fifty (150) feet of any entrance of City Hall.
- There shall be no campaign stickers, signs, or other forms of campaign advertisements displayed on and/or affixed to vehicles parked within one hundred fifty (150) feet of any entrance of City Hall. This applies to vehicles parked in the back parking lot, parameter parking spaces, and any other parking spaces within one hundred fifty (150) feet of any entrance of City Hall.
- Wearing T-shirts, buttons, stickers, etc., with a candidate's name or picture on it, within one hundred fifty (150) feet on any entrance to a building where an election is being conducted, constitutes the posting of campaign literature and is prohibited. Such paraphernalia must be covered or removed before a voter comes within one hundred fifty (150) feet of any entrance to City Hall.
- It is unlawful for any candidate for elective office, or any representative of a candidate, to post or distribute cards, posters, or other campaign literature within one hundred fifty (150) feet of any entrance to City Hall.
- Influencing voters and interrupting the election process is prohibited.
- No loitering is allowed within thirty (30) feet of City Hall.
