### Emergency Shelters:

#### **BILLY BRUMFIELD HOUSE (Stewpot Community Services)**

Services: Emergency shelter for males 18 and over; alcohol and drug rehabilitation; room and board for disabled men; assistance with finding permanent housing.  
Length of Stay: 4 days per week for emergency shelter (starts over each Sunday); minimum of 3 months' stay for rehab and disabled program participants.  
ID Required: Picture ID, Social Security card.

#### **FLOWERS HOUSE (Stewpot Community Services)**

Services: Emergency shelter for women and children only. Provides supportive services such as case management, referrals and counseling.  
Length of Stay: Up to 30 days.
